Teacher Representative – Kim Hand

- The Staff wanted thank the PTSA for a wonderful Teacher Appreciation Week that was run very well and happily received without causing too much of a distraction to the classroom time.
- We will begin a new testing program next year Smarter Balance. This is a national testing program that is part of Common Core. Whenever there is a change, there is usually a dip in scores, so the student body and parents should be prepared. Sample questions are available online at SmarterBalance.org.
 - Mari Stevens noted that because the testing is online, getting kids ready with keyboard skills would be very helpful.
 - Shana Jukes commented that Common Core also has an Iphone/Ipad app that outlines the basics of Common Core and sample work projects.
- Kim is going through her National Board Certification and for a Sociology program, she talked with her class about Tent City 4 in Sammamish and how people on both sides might feel. The Fifth Grade Class worked to serve a meal to Tent City and gather supplies.

Current Business
