This will give access classrooms a laptop for every child. As our testing becomes more and more online, our students need more keyboarding and general computing skills. The total cost is between \$49,000 and \$51,000. Kari Ann Tuohy moved to vote and Juliette Dixon seconded. The vote was passed unanimously.
